Program design

Groups of four or fewer,
three sessions weekly,
20–30 minutes each

Instruction

Evidence-based curriculum,
qualified tutors, aligned to
Michigan standards

Progress monitoring

Student growth, fidelity,
attendance, dosage

Provider eligibility

Approved qualification
pathway, district
partnership, fiscal agent

- Funds distributed (Mar. 1–15)
- Tutoring begins
