Students Served: Serving students with Autism Spectrum Disorder, Emotional Disability, Multiple Disabilities, Other Health Impairment, and Specific Learning Disability. Serving students who were removed from a traditional school setting for serious behavioral violations.

Staff: Our educators shine a positive light on students, uncover the unique learner within, and make a lasting impact.

In partnership with school districts in Central Pennsylvania, Capital Academy helps students reset and refocus. Our private day school supports students in grades K-12 referred by their home school district due to behavioral challenges that have held them back academically and socially.

Based on nurturing a positive peer culture, Capital Academy utilizes a research-based behavioral modification model that cultivates prosocial behaviors and leadership skills through early interventions. Our students learn to embrace personal accountability for behavioral and academic success in an environment that values safety, respect, teamwork, and high standards.

Spark: Academic and Behavior Support

We inspire students to achieve academic success by helping them strengthen their behavioral and learning abilities through a district-aligned curriculum designed to lead the way to less restrictive settings.



Spring: Instruction and Life Skills

We support student performance through a tailored combination of academic, behavioral, and functional communication support to help ensure sustainable growth in more traditional classrooms.



Bloom: Functional Communication and Daily Living

We foster engagement in students diagnosed with autism and cognitive disabilities by helping them strengthen functional academic, communication, and life skills in a nurturing, supportive environment.



Early Behavioral: Elementary Therapeutic and Behavior Support

We help young learners with intensive behavioral needs by providing therapeutic, targeted support in small, nurturing classes. In this positive and safe environment, students can grow socially, emotionally, and academically.
