Based on nurturing a positive peer culture, **FCS PEAK Academy** utilizes a research-based behavioral modification model that cultivates pro-social behaviors and leadership skills through early interventions and tangible rewards. Our students earn field trips and other incentives, and learn to embrace personal accountability for behavioral and academic success in an environment that values respect, teamwork, and high standards.

In partnership with Fulton County Schools, our school helps students in grades 6-12 increase attendance rates, gain access to community resources, show demonstrated growth in reading and math, and begin to enjoy going to school every day with the goal of successfully returning to their home schools.
