

New Jersey Students Achieve Accelerated Math Growth



Students from City of Burlington Public Schools Outpace National Peers with High-Impact Tutoring



City of Burlington Public Schools partnered with Catapult Learning to implement a NJ Department Of Education grant-funded, in-person High-Impact Tutoring program designed to support students performing below grade-level expectations.

Results from the 2024–25 school year show academic growth across multiple grade levels:

3rd Grade (Fall to Winter)

Students outgrew national peers by

(Catapult growth = 24.58
vs. national 7.55)

of students had growth percentiles above 80%, surpassing the pace of 80% of their peers

4th Grade (Fall to Spring)

(Catapult growth = 18.32
vs. national 10.43)

(Catapult growth = 15.38
vs. national 8.73)
